Announced in June of 2019, the National OA Committee approved several changes to membership and program within the OA as follows:

- Brotherhood Requirements: Effective Immediately! The waiting period between Ordeal and Brotherhood eligibility has been reduced to six (6) months.
- Journey to Excellence (JTE): The OA Lodge JTE program
 has been immediately discontinued and replaced with the
 new Performance Measurement Program (PMP) to set
 clear benchmarks for lodge achievements.
