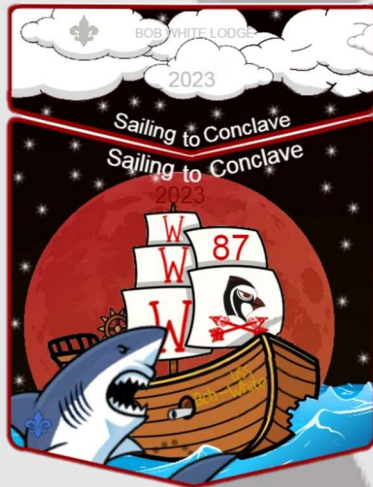
## UPCOMING EVENTS
