## **CAMPOREE**

We hosted our annual camporee Race for the Golden Quail on March 3-4, 2023, at Robert E. Knox Scout Reservation. This year we had 10 Troops participate



in this event. We hosted 19 activities for 119 Scouts and 37 Scouters to compete in. Scouts progressed in



navigation challenges by cycling and running; a First Aid challenge testing skills; a campsite challenge with tents, rain flys and fire building; and an Archery challenge testing skills with different bows at varying distances and targets.

They tested their skills tying a total of 309 knots from hitches to Lashings culminating in the Chariot Race. Scouts competed in rifle team competitions and a final tic-tac-toe event where one Scout from each Patrol competed in a single elimination style competition. This event is a big highlight for Scouts in the Council, and a big way the Lodge has provided service to the Council.





### SPRING FELLOWSHIP

This Spring Fellowship we had 114 scouters attend, as we welcomed 24 new



members and had 19 members seal their membership. We had a great turn out for fellowship helping with redoing a ramp on the back of the Sewell Center, painting the new Trading Post, installing trail trash bins, building a new Dining hall field fence, restructuring the disc golf course, and creating challenge cubes. Our brotherhood members helped with making a new sign for camp to be used as a picture spot as one enters Camp Knox. This weekend was a huge success; we had a great turn out and we can't wait for the next fellowship.






## **E-7 CORNERSTONE CONCLAVE**
