Camporee Theme: The Race for the Golden Quail

Come join the fun of competing in Georgia-Carolina Council's 2023 Spring Camporee as your Scout's scouting and camping skill are tested. Take part in the many events for The Race for the Golden Quail!

When: March 3th – 5th, 2023

Where: Robert E. Knox Scout Reservation located at: 1150 Fred R. Prather Parkway, Lincolnton, GA 30817

Who: This event is open to all Georgia-Carolina Council Scouting BSA Troops.

Cost: \$20.00 per youth, \$15.00 per adults

Deadline to Register: February 27th, 2023 at 11:59 PM

Check-in Time: Friday, March 3th, starting at 6:00 PM. Last check in time is 8:00 PM.

Check-out Time: Sunday, March 5th, by 10:00 AM

Check in information: Check in will be held at the Admin Building.

Troop & Patrol rosters, medical forms, event volunteer names, and song/skits registration form must be turned in at check-in. All

troops must be checked in by Scoutmaster (SM) / Assistant

Scoutmaster (ASM) and Senior Patrol Leader (SPL) / Assistant Senior Patrol Leader (ASPL).

All communication should be through the SPL / ASPL.

Vehicles in camp: No vehicles will be allowed in campsites. Handicap vehicles are allowed per Camp Ranger approval. All vehicles must remain in assigned the parking lots.

Transport of troop gear: Troop vehicles/trailers will be allowed to carry gear to their campsite. Trailers will be allowed to remain in the campsite. Troop vehicle and vehicle carrying trailer must return to parking lots promptly. Any gear not carried in Troop vehicle/trailer **MUST** be packed/carried into your campsite. Only 1 vehicle will be allowed to carry gear to/from the campsite.

Check-out: No Troops will be allowed to remove their trailers until campsite has been all cleared by a member of the camporee committee starting at 9 AM on Sunday, March 5th, 2023. No vehicles will be allowed into campsites until after 9 AM on Sunday, March 5st, 2023. Only one vehicle will be allowed into the campsites between 9 AM and 10 AM. After all clear on campsite, Scoutmaster (SM) / Assistant Scoutmaster (ASM) and Senior Patrol Leader (SPL) / Assistant Senior Patrol Leader (ASPL) must stop by Admin Building for final check out and to pick up your troops medical forms and camporee packets (patches and score sheets).

Competition Awards: Awards will be given out (1st, 2nd, 3rd) for each competition. The unit with the most accurate time to complete the race, will win the **Golden Quail!**

Camping: All camping will be done as Patrol camping using the Patrol Method. Remember to "Leave No Trace"!

Two Deep Leadership and Buddy System must be enforced at all times!

Troop Responsibilities: Each Troop *may* be asked to provide **1 Adult** to assist in running events, inspect and judge. Turn in the names of your adult helpers at check-in. Any additional help will be mentioned during the meeting Friday night.

**** We reserve the right to cancel events due to lack of SPL / adult help or weather.**

Events

The exact details of the events will be kept secret until Patrol Leader meeting on Friday evening.

The Race for the Golden Quail is a race against time and accuracy in a rally race style event beginning with a shotgun start. Your Patrols will race from event to event using a variety of tools and clues! You will be timed from the start of the event to the finish. Whoever completes their tasks in the closest time to the target time will win the Golden Quail! If a patrol fails to complete a task, they will incur a **time penalty of 15 minutes**.

A patrol can earn precious points back at each station, for:

Patrol Flag – 10 seconds

Patrol Yell – 10 seconds
