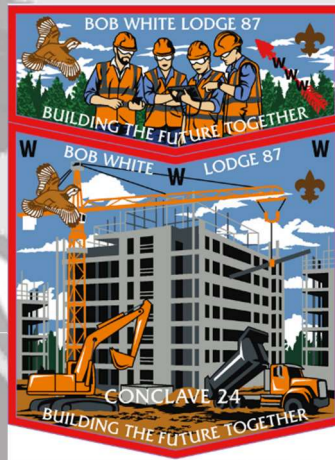
## E-7 CORNERSTONE CONCLAVE

and American Indian dance competitions. Our theme this year is Construction.

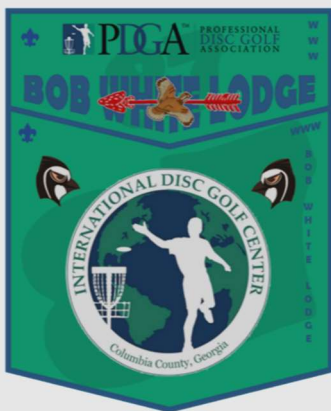

The National Order of the Arrow Conference (NOAC) is the flagship national Order of the Arrow event. It is held every two years at a major university campus and is attended by as many as 8,000 Arrowmen from all 50 states and Lodges in Europe and the Far East. It is second only to the Scouts BSA National Jamboree in size and scope. Our Lodge will be sending a contingent of around 20 Arrowmen and will have many Arrowmen on Staff.
